All recommendations from our Leadership Team were overwhelmingly passed by a membership vote. The Special Session of the Michigan Annual Conference will ratify our decision to disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church on November 30, 2023. We will liquidate the Sackett Endowment Fund for the purpose of payment to the UMC as part of the disaffiliation agreement and then become members of the Global Methodist Church effective January 1, 2024. At that time, we will officially become known as **Ithaca Living Hope Church**. New name. Same God.
